### Manager's Report

#### Follow-up/General Updates

1. Demolition –
  - a) The City had the contract signing with Feline Excavation and Construction on Tuesday, October 15<sup>th</sup> for the two (2) structures, (Former Subaru Garage Dealership Rt. 19 South and the Stealey Assembly of God's Church Parsonage on Milford Street) in the amount of \$92,395. Feline will begin demolition project in early November.
  - b) Former Centra West Virginia Transit Authority (CWVTA) Bus Garage – The Clarksburg Urban Renewal Authority approved and awarded the demolition to reclaim in the amount of \$255,999.
2. Fall Clean-up is continuing through Friday, October 25<sup>th</sup>. Through the first two (2) weeks we have collected one hundred and thirty-seven (137) tons of debris.

#### Police & Fire

1. Police – There will be a Promotional Swearing-In Tuesday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> at 10am in the Council Chambers PFC Quinn will be promoted to Sergeant and Sergeant Williams is being promoted to Lieutenant.
2. Police Personnel –
  - a) The candidates began the Eligibility Process with the Physical Agility Test, which was held on Saturday, October 12<sup>th</sup>. There were forty-one (41) applicants out of sixty-one (61) applicants whom participated. Thirty-five (35) passed the Physical Agility Test.
  - b) The next phase of the Eligibility Process is the Written Test, which will be administered on Wednesday, October 30<sup>th</sup>.
3. Fire – There will be a Firefighter Swearing-In Ceremony for Mr. John Handschumacher on Monday, October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2013 in Council Chambers at 9:00am.

#### Sanitary Board

1. WWTP (Waste Water Treatment Plant) – The Bid opening was held on Wednesday, October 16<sup>th</sup> at 2pm. There were five (5) contractors whom submitted bids on Project A and one (1) who bid on Project B. Thrasher Engineer, the Board's Engineer, is currently reviewing the bids and will provide the Sanitary Board with a recommendation.
