Economic Development

1. Robinson Grand Theatre –
 - a) Larson Design Group – they will be providing geotechnical exploration services, which involve core drilling at eight (8) different locations. Public Works Department has removed the appropriate sections of seats to allow for this project, which will begin within the next several weeks.
 - b) Update Meeting – Assistant City Manager and myself had a meeting with WYK Associates team for a progress meeting on Thursday, June 4th.
 - i. Considerable conversation was held in regards to the operational functions for the Theatre and Banquet Hall.
 - i. Discussion of drainage for storm and sanitary as well as mechanical equipment, adjacent utilities and asbestos abatement.
2. State Office –
 - a) Contractor is framing the interior of the building on 1st and 3rd floors.
 - b) Contractor is framing the exterior of the building on 1st and 4th floors.
