

## CITY MANAGERS REPORT/UPDATE

### Announcements:

1. First Fridays is tomorrow in the downtown and Jackson Square area.
2. Saturday Oct 15th, the annual Pumpkin Spooktacular will be held on the lawn of the Waldamore from 6-9 PM.
3. RCB High School homecoming parade will be held Wednesday, October 19<sup>th</sup>, in downtown from 6-7 pm.

### FIRE DEPARTMENT:

1. The fire department responded to 277 calls for service.
2. Fire Prevention Week is October 09 thru 15<sup>th</sup>, the dept. will be giving fire truck rides on Sunday afternoon and accepting nonperishable food items to be donated to the Mustard Seed.

### POLICE DEPARTMENT:

1. During the month of September, the police dept. responded to 2118 calls for service.
2. Final interviews were held for applicants for the department.

### CLARKSBURG CITY PARKS:

1. The Splash Zone finished the season with 31,000 patrons.
2. The restoration of the waterslides at Splash Zone is scheduled in April 2023.
3. Anyone wishing to sponsor City Parks Trunk or Treat on Saturday, October 22 can contact the City Parks office.

### CODE ENFORCEMENT:

1. Have issued 43 building permits in past month, totaling \$644,744.19.
2. Have issued 79 Notice of Violations, issued 4 citations, and completed 24 inspections.
3. Engineering Dept. is working on Liberty Av. Soil testing, Milford St. storm drain repair and Euclid Av. Sewer repair.

#### **PUBLIC WORKS:**

1. Public works is completing a sewer line project on Euclid Av. Installing 250 ft. of new 8 inch line.
2. Fall clean-up as of Thursday was 19 loads, 26.22 tons at a cost of \$959.67

#### **ROBINSON GRAND:**

1. Four Halloween movies are playing during the month of October.
2. The "Friends of the Robinson Grand" membership program has been launched.

#### **ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:**

#### **WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT:**

1. The plant treated 239 million gallons of wastewater in September with no violations.
2. Jody Ash will be retired on September 23<sup>rd</sup>., with 38 years of service.
