Announcements:

FIRE DEPARTMENT:

1. The Fire Department responded to 276 calls for service in October.
2. The department completed a major upgrade to their Breathing Air system

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

1. Sgt. Joseph M. Walsh will be retiring on November 04, 2022, from the Department after 21 years of dedicated Service.
2. Four new officers will be sworn in on November 04, 2022, at 1000 am in council chambers.
3. Speeding study was completed on Buena Vista Av., in two-week time period, 1976 vehicles traveled on the roadway, with zero speeding violations and an average speed of 14 mph.

CODE ENFORCEMENT:

1. In last two weeks of October, dept. issued 34 building permits totaling \$274,845.00.
2. Issued 22 Notice of Violations, 4 condemnation orders, completed 16 inspections, and responded to 32 animal complaints.
