Updates from City Manager, Tiffany Fell



On July 1, 2023, Clarksburg's newly elected City Council members were sworn into form our city's latest city government. It is normal, at the start of something new, to anticipate change and to hope for improvements in areas that are important to you. We, as city leadership, feel the same way.

As the city begins its new fiscal year, we are looking forward to and making plans for the moving of our city forward. One of the ways we hope to do that is by addressing a key issue that citizens have repeatedly expressed is needed-- better communication.

Better Communication

The City of Clarksburg is committed to improving our communication with citizens. When I started as City Manager in June of this year, the city's primary forms of communication were social media and occasionally the city website, with the most utilized tool being Facebook. People have reminded us that not everyone uses Facebook. For that reason, we are adding two new forms of communication: a publication like this in the Exponent Telegram

which will appear every other Friday and the creation of a monthly newsletter which will be distributed utilizing an opt-in email list, social media, and the city website. These forms of communication will evolve as we determine the most effective ways to use them for communication and engagement with citizens.
