

## **NEWS RELEASE FALL CLEAN UP 2025**

The City of Clarksburg will again sponsor its **Annual Residential Only Fall Clean-Up**. Open trucks will be available to take items too large and bulky for normal garbage pick-up. IE: Stoves, washers, dryers, hot water tanks, electronic equipment such as televisions, microwaves or computers, and normal household items. Refrigerators, air conditioners, and freezers must be properly tagged, noting that all Freon has been professionally removed. Without proof of Freon removal, the above items will **NOT** be picked up. **No** normal household garbage and demolition/construction material, corrugated cardboard and broken glass (unless the broken glass is boxed or contained so that no one can get cut) will be taken. (Limited to one small truck load per residence.)

Vehicle parts, batteries and tires along with liquids (example-paint, sealer, and etc.) will **NOT** be picked up. Auto Zone at 106 W. Main will accept used motor oil. Clarksburg Scrap Metals at 702 N. Ohio Avenue and Nicholson Auto, Inc. at 168 Peck Street receives old vehicle parts and all appliances.

To take advantage of this FREE service, Clarksburg residents are requested to place items at the curb or in the alley by 7:00 a.m. on your designated day. **PLEASE PLACE ITEMS OUT IF POSSIBLE THE EVENING BEFORE YOUR SCHEDULED DAY. Small items must be boxed, bagged, or tied. Nothing loose will be taken. All containers must be disposable and of a size and weight one man can hoist up into a dump truck bed.

No materials from contractor's jobs will be included in this free service. Items not properly prepared will **NOT** be taken. Yard Waste will not be included in this pick up, but will be picked up by our Compost Department truck on the designated day.

**The three (3) weeks schedule will be as follows:**

**Week 1:**

**MONDAY-September 22:** All of Adamston from North of bridge, Glenwood Hills, & Edgewood Areas.

**TUESDAY-September 23:** Glen Elk 1 includes N. 5<sup>th</sup> Street, part of Baltimore, Wholesale, Hogans Lane, Clark, Leggett, Werninger, Ford, and N. 4<sup>th</sup> Streets; the north side of W. Pike Street from N. 4<sup>th</sup> Street to the West End Bridge, including Walnut, Hewes, Mulberry, Beech, Birch, Locust, Northcott, Everett, Peck, Gandy, Camden Place, Martha Street and any other side streets normally serviced in these areas. Baltimore and Coleman Avenues, A&B Streets, Point Comfort – all streets on both sides of W. Pike Street to the south side of the Adamston bridge.

**WEDNESDAY-September 24:** North View from N. 12<sup>th</sup> Street through N. 16<sup>th</sup> Street and all streets in between. This includes Alpha Avenue, all of Richards Avenue, Nutter Alley and all of Pearlman Avenue but excluding Riverside Area.

**THURSDAY-September 25:** North View from N. 17<sup>th</sup> Street through N. 21<sup>st</sup> Street and all streets in between.

**FRIDAY-September 26:** Northview from N. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street through N. 25<sup>th</sup> Street and all of Riverside Addition to Green Avenue. All streets in this area.

**WEEK 2:**

**MONDAY-September 29:** Lower Stealey Area-Park Blvd, Fairview, Grove, Kuhl, Upper Davis Street, Hall Street, Nicholas Street back to Hall, down Milford to Lower Hart Street and all streets in between North Avenue, Stealey Avenue, Duff to Hall, Baker, Ridenour, Carpenter, Nicholas, Mine, and Ray Court.

**TUESDAY-September 30:** Middle Stealey Area-Duff from Hall Street up to and including W. Woodland, Waverly Way, John, Temple Terrace, Rodney to Euclid, Ryder, Pick, Simpson, Fittro, Ash, Coolidge, Joseph, Hemsworth Way, Milford Street back to Euclid.

**WEDNESDAY-October 1:** Upper Stealey Area – Starting at Duncan, Upper Hart Street, West Drive, Winding Way to White Avenue, Lewis, Marion, Bayer, King, Collins, Redbud, McDowell, Morgan, Bond, Shinn, and lower section of Davis Street.

**THURSDAY-October 2:** From Sampson Street, the south side of Milford Street to Liberty Avenue. Hartland Area, Chestnut Hills Area including Kramer Drive, Camden Street, Thorn, Harvey, Custer, Frederick, Dane and streets in this area.

**FRIDAY-October 3:** From the West End Bridge: all streets on the south side of West pike and West Main Street – Glendale, Holt, Ferry, Stuart, Sumner, Dale, Washington, Dodge Court, Jasper, Lynch; the sections of Lee, Hornor and all side streets up to S. 4<sup>th</sup> Street; South chestnut from W. Main to Kramer Drive and all streets in these areas. From E.B. Saunders to S. 5<sup>th</sup> Street; everything on the south side of W. Main Street up to Clifton. Both sides of W. Pike Street from E.B. Saunders to 2<sup>nd</sup> Street; School, Chapel, Sheridan, Gore, and N. 1<sup>st</sup> Street.

**WEEK 3:**

**MONDAY-October 6:** Broadway area; Marshall Street to Buckhannon Pike at Haymond Highway; Waldeck, Lang, Spring, Hedge, Rosemont, St. Clair and a portion of Harrison Street and all streets in these areas.

**TUESDAY-October 7:** Upper Broad Oaks area, Suan Terrace, Arbutus Park, and Nixon Plaza, plus any streets in these areas.

**WEDNESDAY-October 8:** Monticello to Elm – south side of East Main including Maple, Clay, Carr, Despard (behind Davis Weaver Funeral Home), Elm, Vermont, Point, Tyler, Howard, Harrison and all streets in these areas. Goff Plaza; all streets on the north side of E. Main Street; E. Pike from N. Monticello to Linden Avenue.

**THURSDAY-October 9:** Goff Plaza: all streets on the north side of E. Main Street; E. Pike from N. Monticello to Linden Avenue; side streets in the area of Church, Grant, Jackson, Oak, Meigs, Maple, etc.

**FRIDAY-October 10:** Kelly Hill areas, both sides of E. Pike from Linden to City Limits; Glen Elk #2; Montpelier Addition and surrounding streets that are in this area. The Hill 'N' Dale, Quarry Development and the Oak Mound/Mapleview Apartment areas and Rosebud Trailer Park and the Stoneybrooke Area.
